POLICY	DETAILS
Availability	Financial Aid forms open in February for the next school year.
Funding	Limited Zakah funds from generous donors. Once funds are depleted, no further aid is available.
Eligibility	Only completed applications with proof of income are considered.
Bison Fund Denial Proof	Families must apply to Bison first and provide proof of denial before seeking aid from Universal School.
Bison Fund Awardees	Students who receive Bison Fund awards are not eligible for additional Universal School Financial Aid.
Bison Fund	The Bison Fund, available through the City of Buffalo, can award up to \$2,100 based on income eligibility.

Tuition Terms

POLICY	DETAILS
Registration Fees	Due at application submission and are non-refundable .
Hifz Program Fee	Due by the 1st of each month alongside monthly tuition payments.
Payment Deadlines	If using Plan 1 and tuition is not paid in full by June 30th, the 5% discount will not apply.
Returned Checks / Insu cient Funds	A \$40 fee applies for returned checks or automatic withdrawals due to insuficient funds.
Records & Transcripts	Will not be released until all tuition obligations are satisifed. Delinquent accounts may result in student suspension.
Payment Allocation	Payments are applied first to any overdue amounts before current charges.
Default on Payments	In cases of consistent non-payment, the school may require ACH or full payment in advance for subsequent years.



HOW IT WORKS

BISON's K-8 scholarships utilize a lottery system based on complete pre-application forms, with a deadline of March 31st each year. New families can click 'Apply Now' to enter the lottery, and post-deadline applications are waitlisted. Our program follows students from their entry until 8th grade, as long as they remain enrolled and financially eligible.

Currently, the maximum award per student for K-8 Scholarships is \$3,000. A required minimum family contribution of \$500 ensures families share BISON's commitment to private education. Our high school scholarships are exclusively awarded to current BISON 8th graders through a lottery drawing. Our high school awards are capped at \$4,500 per student. With BISON's expansion to high school, we help families provide a seamless educational journey from elementary to high school for their child.

For our high school program, scholarships are exclusively awarded to current BISON 8th graders through a lottery drawing. Families receiving the annual \$4,500 award can use it at any of our area's private high schools, ensuring a seamless educational journey from elementary to high school for BISON scholars.

BISON is an independent organization separate from Universal School.

Universal School does <u>NOT</u> review or determine the status of the application.

Cullen Scholars Program (Erie County Only)

The Cullen Foundation supports high-achieving 5th grade students who plan to attend private middle and high schools through its Cullen Scholars program. Scholarships are renewable for up to seven years, covering partial tuition plus an annual technology/activity stipend.

5th graders entering 6th grade in 2025–2026 Must maintain a "B" average or above Must meet income requirements (see chart online) Must reside in Erie County

Scholarship Amount

Middle School (6th–8th): Covers up to \$4,050 of base tuition + \$250 annual stipend High School (9th–12th): Covers full base tuition + \$500 annual stipend Note: Recipients are ineligible for a BISON Scholarship.
